COURSE DETAILS

TARGET GROUP

Community development practitioners and/or social work practitioners and/or professionals working with corporate social investment funds and /or professionals from non-profit organizations and/or health care practitioners in public health care.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Participants will first undergo a paper-based screening for admission (participants should at least have Grade 12 or an equivalent NQF level 4). There after participants will be invited for an interview to determine whether they adhere to the following admission requirements:

- Participants should have basic computer skills.
- Participants should have intrapersonal skills.
- Participants should have proficiency in English.
- Participants should have access to a computer.
- Participants should have access to internet connection.
- Participants should be actively involved in a community.
